### **Susan K. Jahns:**

Susan has been a designated broker since 1985. In 1998, Sue received a Master's Degree in Education (Educational Media and Computers) from Arizona State University. Her personal philosophy of instruction was incorporated into today's teaching method: *It is important to select clear objectives and to teach to those objectives through relevant instruction, practice, questions, and feedback. Teachers must build rapport, use effective classroom management skills and create a classroom atmosphere, which matches the learning activity. Instruction must be monitored and adjusted based on the students' understanding of the material.* Susan has been an adjunct professor for ASU, NAU, and Central Arizona College. She redesigned CAC's curriculum to match the ADRE's objectives; she is the liaison between CAC and the Arizona Department of Real Estate for all approved courses. In addition to writing new courses for the college, she has written and teaches ADRE approved continuing education courses for Jahns School of Real Estate and Computers.
